PRESIDENTS REPORT

Matthew McDonough

It is with great pride and appreciation that I present the President's Report for the 2024–2025 season of the Victorian Athletic League (VAL).

Having served on the Board since 2020 and in the role of President for the past four seasons, this moment offers both a chance to reflect and to look forward. The journey has not always been without challenge, but the progress we have made as an organisation is both undeniable and deeply rewarding.

This past season represents a high watermark in the League's modern history. Across every major metric—participation, financial performance, public engagement, and stakeholder relationships—the VAL is in the strongest position it has been in for decades.

Membership has seen sustained growth, rising by 27% over the past three seasons. Event entries surged again this year by 28%, and by 58% since 2020. Notably, our junior participation continues to rise, and for the past two seasons we have proudly delivered equal prizemoney across male and female categories— an achievement that reinforces our commitment to equality and inclusion.

Our financial position has also strengthened considerably. This season alone, revenue grew by 16%, bringing our four-year growth to 51%. Most impressively, our net profit increased by 796% this year—an overall rise of 531% over the past four years. These outcomes are the result of strong stewardship, deliberate planning, and a clear strategic vision.

In a significant milestone for the VAL, we successfully secured several new league sponsors and, for the first time, a naming rights partner. This is a momentous achievement and one that underpins both the financial stability and the forward momentum of the League. I extend my thanks to those who played a role in this breakthrough.

Our digital presence has also been completely revitalised. Through a strategic partnership formed 3 years ago with Didier from Fixon Media, we have seen exponential growth in engagement. Instagram increased by 586%, Facebook by 181%, and our race video content reached 34.9 million views—a 591% increase. These figures speak not only to the excitement of our events but also to the broadening interest in the sport across communities.

Operational improvements have continued in parallel. This season saw the implementation of a new membership and race-day results database, improving efficiency and enhancing the athlete and spectator experience. Our collaboration with leagues nationally, particularly the strengthened relationship with SAAL, is among the best it has been—setting the tone for greater unity and shared ambition across the sport.

We also proudly hosted and steered two major VAL events—Geelong Gift and Bendigo Gift, both were a great success. In collaboration with the Stawell Athletic Club, SGEM, and 360 Events we supported one of the most successful Stawell Gift Carnivals in more than two decades. After years of decline in distance running participation, we are now seeing a slight resurgence, with participation numbers increasing 8% this year.

These results are only possible thanks to the extraordinary efforts of many. I extend my deep thanks to our athletes, volunteers, clubs, sponsors, and supporters who form the backbone of our sport. The Office Administrator role began in challenging circumstances but has been critical in ensuring a successful season and continues to flourish.

While we have every reason to celebrate, it is equally important to acknowledge that we stand at a critical juncture. Strong foundations and momentum have been built, but ongoing progress will depend on continued collaboration, aligned leadership, and a willingness to put the interests of the sport above all else. The future of the VAL requires unity, strategic clarity, and an enduring commitment to innovation.

I have again enjoyed and feel honoured to serve as VAL President. I have always sought to act in the best interests of the sport, even when that meant navigating differences of opinion and competing priorities. Progress is rarely linear, but the results achieved over the past four years reflect what is possible when the focus remains on the greater good.



CHIEF STEWARDS REPORT

This season started off with a few complications. The loss of our CEO forced Kim McDonough to take on the role and with the new SAAL system in place it was a momentous role that she conquered. My role as Chief Steward was made much easier by her support and expertise.

Our numbers were up substantially which impacted on stewards and handicappers but was the catalyst for a very successful season and a fantastic Stawell.

The VAL had a terrific season and this is only possible because of the enormous efforts by the participating clubs. As a panel we were looked after by all clubs with ample support, food and drink.

The ground preparations were much improved with handicap marks provided and good surfaces. It would be good if the clubs could provide posts every ten metres on the circular track so that athletes can see the line and run outside it.

The competing athlete numbers were excellent with competitive racing each week. A few athletes were asked to front the stewards for various reasons and a percentage of these would be reduced if prerace correspondence detailing issues was given.

We have sent some suggestions to the Board and HRP to peruse and feel that they may be helpful to the development of our sport. There needs be an alignment between VAL handicapping/stewarding and some of our outdated rules. At the moment there is ambiguity within and while we know the board continually works on this, it is an area that we must not relax on.

Track allowances are an issue each season and while conditions may vary from year to year it might be clearer to nominate allowances for the fast tracks before the season commences. Any amendments may be made after the meeting. The 14 day injury suspension is also a concern with when does the suspension commence with meetings on Saturdays and Sundays, it may be more practical to have meeting suspensions rather than days.

The stewarding panel were stalwarts during the season, I convey a big thank you to the cohorts Chad Ryan and John Henry who were diligent every week.

Referees Terry O'Donnell and Sue Dunbar must also be acknowledged while Matt Boyes must also be thanked for his support and help at Stawell. The tent crew led by Nila are tremendous support for myself and handicappers.

We must work closely with all handicappers and as a steward I deeply appreciated the help and support from them. These people do a wonderful job to keep the VAL operating on a weekly basis. Thank you to Colin, Jono and Kim. It is very gratifying to have director of handicapping Colin whose expertise, fairness and honesty benefits our sport immensely.

GOVERNANCE

Overview

The Victorian Athletic League (VAL) is an incorporated association under the Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012 (Vic). 19345. Its purpures are set out in the constitution:

(a)To acquire all assets and assume all responsibility for the payment of all financial liabilities of the incorporated association known as the Victorian Athletic League Inc.

(b)To promote a greater community awareness of professional foot running and its contribution to the community generally.

(c)To undertake and assume the control and conduct of athletic events conducted at meetings sanctioned by the Association, and to affiliate and/or likewise liaise with such bodies as have similar (in whole or in part) purposes.

(d)On behalf of its Members to ensure that all athletic meetings held under the auspices of the Association are conducted in accordance with the rules and Regulations of the Association, and to appoint officials to supervise athletic meetings and to order examinations of any person involved in such meetings as to their performance, conduct or identity.

(e)On behalf of its members to deal with any breach of the rules and Regulations set down by the Association for participation in athletic meetings by clubs, societies, managing bodies or individuals, and to endorse or remove any disqualifications or suspensions which result from any breach of the rules by Clubs, societies, managing bodies or individuals.

(f)To reciprocate with any recognised athletic, cycling, running, swimming or other association promoting the pursuit of athletic activities, provided always that any such activities must not be conducted for the purpose of profit or gain to the association's individual members.

GOVERNANCE

Rules and Regulations

The Committee may make regulations and/or bylaws and alter, amend or rescind the same as occasions may require, and enforce penalties for their breach. Such regulations and by-laws shall have the same force and effect as the Rules but shall not be in any way opposed or in conflict with the Rules. Such Regulations and by-laws shall be available for inspection in the League premises and duly circulated to Members.

Membership

The Members shall be, and shall be divided into, the following classes:

- (a) Affiliated Members (Clubs)
- (b) Life Members.
- (c) Registered Athletes and Trainers

Quorum

14.2 No item of business shall be transacted at a General Meeting unless a quorum of Members entitled under the Rules to vote is

Seven Members entitled to vote personally present (by way of Delegate or otherwise) constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business at a General Meeting.

Voting at General Meetings

17.1 Members shall have the following voting rights in General Meeting.

(a) Affiliated Members shall be entitled to appoint one Delegate, each of whom shall be entitled to participate in debate and exercise one vote on behalf of his Affiliated Member at General Meetings of the Association.

(b) Registered Athletes and Trainers shall not be entitled to vote, but shall be entitled to participate in debate, at general meetings of the Association; and

(c) Life Members shall not be entitled to vote, but shall be entitled to participate in debate, at general meetings of the Association.

All votes shall be given personally, or by proxy.

A question arising at a General Meeting of the Association shall be determined by a show of hands, unless a Member requests a poll.

In the case of an equality of voting on a question, the Chairperson of the meeting may exercise a second or casting vote.

Financial Snapshot

Victorian Athletic League – Financial Summary 2024–2025

The Victorian Athletic League recorded an operating profit of \$32,340 for the 2024–2025 financial year. Notably, revenue increased by 16% compared to the previous year, largely driven by strong growth in athlete entries across all meetings. This positive trend not only contributed to the League's financial position but also resulted in increased entry fee payments to clubs. As participation continues to rise, additional resourcing will be required to ensure events maintain the high standards expected by athletes, clubs, and stakeholders.


This year's surplus reflects the collective efforts of many, including the successful acquisition of new sponsorships. We were particularly pleased to welcome Williams Shoes (www.williamsshoes.com.au) as a key sponsor of the League and selected events. We extend our sincere thanks to Williams for their support and encourage athletes and supporters to visit their stores or website when purchasing their next pair of shoes.


Expenditure rose moderately, primarily due to targeted investments in equipment and an increase in operational costs at events. These included additional honorarium payments and accommodation expenses for our valued volunteers. We also incurred costs associated with the integration and continuous improvement of our new competition management and back-office systems, including alignment with our website.

The Board remains committed to maintaining a sustainable financial position. Over the past four years, League revenue has grown by 51%, enabling stronger operational support and the creation of a provision to fund future equipment replacement and infrastructure needs.



1. PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activity of the association is to organise and operate professional running events for the benefit of the Athletic Clubs and their members.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Victorian Athletic League Inc. is an association incorporated and domiciled in Australia with its registered office at Lakeside Stadium Albert Park.

(a) Statement of Compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Australian Accounting Standards issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board and the disclosure requirements of Chapter 2M of the Corporations Law.

(b) Basis of Financial Statements Preparation

The financial statements, expressed in Australian dollars, are prepared on the historical cost basis.

(c) Non-current Assets

Non-current assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is calculated on a diminishing value basis so as to write off the cost of plant and equipment over their estimated useful lives as follows:-

•	Plant and Equipment	9-11 years
•	Office Equipment	3-5 years
•	Database	5 years

The above rates are consistent with the prior period and are reviewed annually to ensure they reflect the remaining useful life of each asset.

(d) Taxation

The Association is registered as a "not for profit organisation" in accordance with of The Income Tax Assessment Act (ITAA97 and ITAA36) and is not required to lodge income tax returns.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

(e) Inventories

The association does carry any inventories at this time. In the event that it becomes necessary; Inventories are carried at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost is calculated using the first-in, first-out method and comprises all cost of purchases and other costs incurred in bringing the inventories to their location and condition at that time. Net realisable value is the estimated selling price in the ordinary course of business less the estimated costs of completion and the estimated costs necessary to make the sale.

(f) Other Receivables

Other receivables are stated at the actual recoverable amounts.

(g) Other Payables

Other payables are stated at cost.

(h) Revenue Recognition

Provided it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the association and the revenue and costs, if applicable, can be measured reliably, revenue is recognised in the income statements when goods/services are delivered at the customers' nominated premises which is taken to be the point in time when the customer has accepted the goods/services and the related risks and rewards of ownership.

(i) Translation of Foreign Currencies

Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into Australian dollars at rates of exchange closely approximate to those ruling at the balance sheet date and transactions in foreign currencies during the year are translated at rates closely approximate to those ruling on transaction dates. Translation differences are dealt with through the income statement.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(j) Impairment

The carrying amounts of the association's assets, other than inventories, are reviewed at each balance sheet date to determine whether there is any indication of impairment. If any such indication exists, the asset's recoverable amount is estimated. For intangible assets that are not yet available for use, the recoverable amount is estimated at each balance sheet date. An impairment loss is recognised whenever the carrying amount of an asset or its cash-generating unit exceeds its recoverable amount. All impairment losses are recognised in the income statement. An impairment loss is reversed if there has been a change in the estimates used to determine the recoverable amount. An impairment loss is only reversed to the extent that the asset's carrying amount does not exceed the carrying amount that would have been determined, net of depreciation or amortisation, if no impairment loss had been recognised. All reversals of impairment are recognised in the income statement.

(k) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the association has a present obligation as a result of a past event where it is probable that it will result in an outflow of economic benefits that can be reasonably estimated.

(I) Financial Instruments

Financial assets and financial liabilities carried on the balance sheet include cash and cash equivalents, other receivables and payables. The accounting policies on recognition and measurement of these items are disclosed in the respective accounting policies found in these Notes.

(m) Related Parties

For the purposes of these financial statements, parties are considered to be related if one party has the ability, directly or indirectly, to control the other party or exercise significant influence over the party in making financial and operating decisions, or vice versa, or where the parties are subject to common control or common significant influence. Related parties may be individuals or other entities.

11. FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT

Credit risk

Credit risk refers to the risk that debtors will default on their obligations to repay the amounts due to the association, resulting in a loss to the association. The association has adopted procedures in extending credit terms to customers and in monitoring its credit risk. The credit policy on extending credit terms to customers includes assessing and evaluating of customers' creditworthiness and financial standing. Management also closely monitors all outstanding debts and reviews the collectability of trade debtors periodically. The maximum exposure to credit risk is represented by the carrying amount of each financial asset in the balance sheet.

Foreign exchange risk

The association does not carry any foreign exchange risk.

Liquidity risk

Liquidity risk refers to the risk in which the association is unable to meet its shortterm obligations. Liquidity risk is minimal and is managed by matching the payment and receipts cycles. The association's operations are financed mainly through trade financing and member clubs' funding.

Fair values

The carrying amounts of the financial assets and liabilities approximate their fair values as at balance sheet date due to their relatively short-term maturity.
